## **LEGO ROBOTICS WITH MINDSTORMS RCX**

Imagine what you can do when you combine Lego bricks with computers! The Lego Robotics Workshop is an introduction to building and programming machines using the Lego Mindstorms Invention System 2.0. Students will have fun designing programmable machines that can walk on legs, or move about on wheels to find their own way and avoid obstacles. Using Lego blocks, motors and sensors, you will learn mechanical design, construction, programming and teamwork skills,. Students use a laptop computer to program their machines to move, react, and make sounds in order to solve challenges (laptops are provided). All equipment is returned to instructor at the end of class.
